Environmental Policy

The Woolley Village Hall Management Committee will manage the Village Hall as sensitively and efficiently as possible, taking into account its a Grade 2 listed building within a conservation area and local environmental issues and national regulations.

Specific policies:-

1. Environmental Effects

Make the most efficient use of energy. It will endeavour to use the minimum quantities of energy possible in accordance with the safe and efficient operation of its heating, lighting, plant and machinery. It will, from time to time, review its energy sources, energy using appliances and energy efficiency with a view to causing the least environmental impact. It will monitor consumption and eliminate excessive or unnecessary use. It will communicate to hirers and staff the means by which energy may be conserved, e.g. closing doors, switching off lights.

2. Environmental Impact

Woolley Village Hall will use environmentally safe and sustainable energy sources to meet our needs and the Village Hall will make every effort to minimise waste and wherever possible recycle materials. All waste will be disposed of through safe and responsible methods, including the operation of a paper/plastic/glass-recycling scheme in conjunction with WMDC.

3. Legislation and Regulations

The Village Hall Committee will review this policy annually, taking into account new guidelines and government directives.

4. Users of Woolley Village Hall

In addition to abiding by the policies detailed above, all parties hiring out or using Woolley Village Hall are responsible for removal and appropriate disposal of any waste generated whilst using the Hall.
